Geography	Internet access – You Tube	<p><u>Learning Question: Do I understand that compass points can be used to show direction?</u> https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=f2l81_BFb-s Sing along with the compass song.</p>
Art/DT	Pencil and paper	<p><u>Learning Question: Can I draw a woodland animal with close observation?</u> Sketch a woodland animal showing the texture of fur or feathers.</p>
PSHE	Pencil and paper	<p><u>Learning Question: Do I recognise how it feels to be proud of an achievement?</u> Tell your adult something that you are proud. E.g. It might be that you have learnt to tie your shoelaces or ride a bike. How does it make you feel to be proud of something?</p>
RE	BBC Bitesize Pencil and paper	<p><u>Learning Question: Can I make a piece of art that explains part of the Creation Story?</u> Watch the video... https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/z62hyrd Draw a picture to show something God created in the creation story.</p>
Music	BBC Teach	<p><u>Learning Question: Can I join in with songs?</u> Encourage your child to join in with the chorus to the song ‘What can you see in the woods?’ https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/bring-the-noise/andys-raps-woodland/zk68382 Ask your child what they saw in the woods in the film. Can they think of other animals that they can see in the woods? Could they try to make the sounds that the animals make?</p>
