We will be learning to:

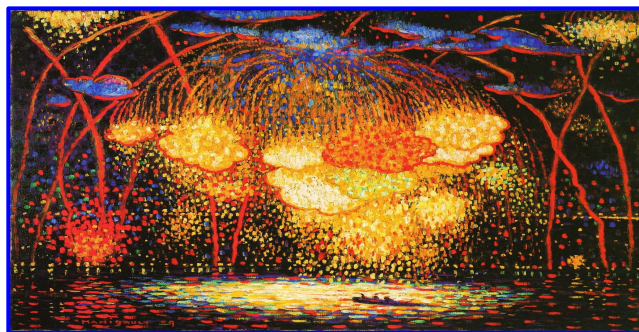
- Subitise objects (recognise sets of objects to 4 without counting)

We will be learning to

- Use paintbrushes carefully

- Making prints
- Explore colour and shape
- Making Christmas related crafts
- Engage in imaginative role-play
