

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in EYFS this half term.

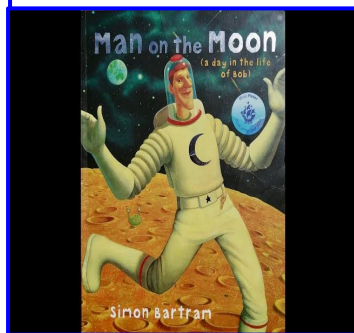
English

- Read simple phrases and captions using our phonic knowledge to help us and recognise tricky words.

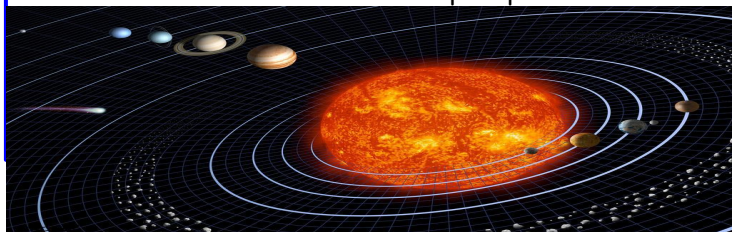


Understanding the World

Expressive Arts and Design

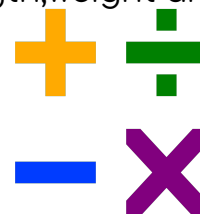
We will be learning to:
