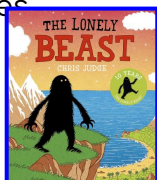


This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in Year 1 this half term.

English

We will be reading 'The Lonely Beast' by Chris Judge. We will be learning to:

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge.
- Learn to spell common exception words.
- Use the prefix "un" and suffixes "er" and "est".
- Use nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Punctuate sentences with a capital letter and full stop.
- Use question marks.



Maths

We will be learning about length and height, multiplication and division and fractions. We will learn to:

- Measure length in cm.
- Use a ruler accurately.
- Compare heights.
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Recognise equal groups.
- Make equal groups by sharing.
- Recognise a half and a quarter of an amount.

Science

Our topic is 'Plants and growth'. We will be learning to:

- Identify parts of a flower.
- Classify flowers according to their properties.
- Identify signs of spring.
- Carry out comparative / fair tests.
- Make predictions.
- Classify and sort.
- Record observations over time.

History

Our topic is 'Local significant people'

We will be learning to

- Know who Charles Darwin is.
- Know who Emma Raducanu is.
- Know why these people are significant.

RE

Our topic is 'Judaism - Shabbat' We will be focussing on

- What Shabbat is and why it is celebrated.
- How Shabbat is celebrated
- What activities Jewish people do during Shabbat

DT

We will be sewing.

We will be:

- Learning safety rules of sewing.
- Designing our own bunting using stencils.
- Evaluating our work.

Computing

Our topic is 'Basic presentations.' We will be learning to

- Learn how to save our presentations.
- How to add text and pictures to a presentation.
- Create a presentation using different font, size and colour.

PSHE

Our topic is 'Relationships'. We will be learning about:

- Who our family members or special people are and what makes them important to us.
- What healthy and safe relationships look like.
- What to do when people are being kind or unkind to us.

Music

Our topic is 'Music Makers.'

Sessions will be taught by Bromley Youth Music Trust.



PE

In PE, we will focus on our physical learning behaviour. We will develop fundamental movement skills:

- Coordination - sending and receiving a ball
- Teamwork - working together
- Control - aiming and sending the ball accurately
