

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in EYFS this half term.

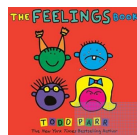
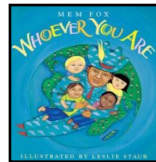
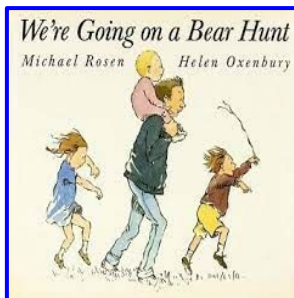
English

We will be reading

We will be learning to

- Sing number rhymes

- Hear and join in with the counting sequence
- Make collections of objects
- Compare two sets

We will be learning to

- Create self portraits using a range of media
- Investigate lines and textures.
- Explore colour mixing.
- Create collages using natural objects.
- Engage in imaginative role-play
