

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in Year 1 this half term. Knowledge organisers can also be found on the Year 1 page on the website with additional information about the curriculum topics.

English

We will be reading 'The Day the Crayons Quit' and 'Lila and the Secret of Rain'. We will be learning to:

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge.
- Learn to spell common exception words.
- Use nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Punctuate sentences with a capital letter and full stop.
- Conjunction 'and'
- Exclamation marks and question marks.



Maths

We will be learning about addition, subtraction and place value. We will learn to:

- Add and subtract within 20.
- Find and make number bonds to 20.
- Find doubles.
- Count from 20 to 50.
- Partition into tens and ones.
- 1 more / 1 less

Geography

Our topic is 'The United Kingdom'

We will be learning to

- Locate our local area.
- Locate the UK on a map.
- Identify UK countries and seas.
- Identify physical features of the UK.
- Describe UK weather patterns.

Science

Our topic is 'Materials.' and 'Seasonal Change' We will be learning to:

- Identify different materials.
- Classify materials according to their properties.
- Identify signs of spring.
- Carry out comparative / fair tests.
- Make predictions.
- Classify and sort.
- Record observations over time.

RE

Our topic is 'Christianity - Palm Sunday' We will be focussing on

- The welcome people gave to Jesus and the reasons why Christians believe he was special.
- Recalling parts of the Easter story, recall what happened on Palm Sunday
- Identifying and understanding the meaning of symbols in the Easter story.

DT

We Will develop an understanding of different ways that material can be joined and learn to sew using the running stitch. The children will design, make and evaluate bunting.

Computing

Our topic is 'Digital Art.' We will be learning to

- Draw a digital picture
- Insert shapes into digital art
- Duplicate an image into digital art.
- Add text
- Create a piece of digital art.

PSHE

Our topic is 'Healthy Me'

- Know the difference between being healthy and unhealthy.
- Know how to keep myself clean and healthy
- Know that medicines can help me if I feel poorly and I know how to use them safely.
- Know now how to keep safe when crossing the road.

Music

Our topic is 'Learning to listen.'

We will be listening, responding and performing a variety of songs.



PE

In PE, we will focus on our creative learning behaviour. We will develop fundamental movement skills:

- Coordination - ball skills.
- Counter balance with a partner.
