English

Class Text - This half term is our class text is *Private Peaceful* by Michael Morpurgo where we will be writing a setting description and a letter. .

Spellings - 3/4 and 5/6 spelling list are on google classroom to practise.

Grammar - We will start by consolidating word classes, clauses and sentence structure.

Maths

This term we are focusing on number (Roman Numerals, factors and multiples), place value (rounding, partitioning and understanding value of numbers) and the four operations (adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.)
