

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in Year 5/6 this half term.

### English

This term we will be reading we will be continuing with Pig Heart Boy as our core text. We will be continuing to base our writing outcomes around the text with the addition of a two week block based on The Day The Crayons Came Home with the remainder of the school to help celebrate World Book Day. Lots of exciting writing opportunities ahead for this half term!

### Maths

This term we will be consolidating our knowledge of fractions. We will also be looking at decimals and percentages.

It is essential children are confident with their times tables to progress in these topics. Please ensure you are continuing to practice these at home. TTRockstars is great for this! Please also have a look at Numbots.

### Art

Our topic is colour theory and painting. We will be looking at different artists and their approaches, to develop our own personal style of painting.

### Science

Our topic is living things and their habitats. We will be looking at classification of plants and animals.

### PE

We will be our outdoor focus will be cricket. The children will work over the 5 weeks to improve our fielding, batting and bowling skills. These skills will then be applied to a small scale version of cricket.

### Geography

We will be focusing on the topic of Population and migration. We will be looking at population patterns and how migration has an effect. We will investigate into differences between countries.

### PSHE

Our topic is Healthy Me. We will be exploring how to look after ourselves physically and mentally.

### RE

Our topic is Christianity. We will be questioning whether Christianity is still a strong religion 2000 years after Jesus was on Earth.
