

This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in EYFS this half term.

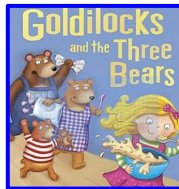
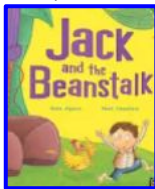
English

We will be reading:

- The Three Little Pigs
- Little Red Riding Hood
- The Gingerbread Man
- Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- Jack and the Beanstalk

We will be learning to:

- Write simple phrases and sentences.
- Retell stories and narratives using their own words.
- Use their phonic knowledge to help spell words.
- Read simple phrases and captions using phonic knowledge
- Recognise tricky words.
- Participate in discussions.



Understanding the World

We will be:

- Exploring the natural world
- Understanding some important processes and changes in the natural world including the seasons.
- Growing and looking after plants.
- Describing some similarities between life in this country and life in other countries.



Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to:

- Safely using and exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques.
- Share creations, explaining the process they have used.
- Learning about artists - Vincent Van Gogh.

Maths

We will be learning:

- Subitising amounts
- Partitioning 5 into different parts.
- The composition of numbers to 10
- More than and fewer than
- One more and one less than numbers
- The order of numbers



PSHE

Our topic is "Keeping Healthy"

We will be learning about:

- The importance of exercise
- Food and that some foods are healthier than others.
- The importance of sleep and what they can do to help themselves get to sleep
- Hand washing and why it is important



PE

Our focus this half term is dance. The children will learn and develop shapes and circles and create sequences of movement with these through partnering and artistry.

RE

Our topic is "What is Easter?"

We will be learning about:

- The signs of Spring
- New life - baby animals
- Easter symbols - eggs, hot cross buns, palm cross
